



Bupa Junior Great North Run

Saturday 18 September 2010, Newcastle/Gateshead Quayside, 3km, for children aged 9-11 and 12-16

The Bupa Junior Great North Run is the North East's biggest and best mini and junior running event, which returns to NewcastleGateshead's Quayside on Saturday 18 September 2010.

The event takes place the day before the world's biggest half marathon the Bupa Great North Run and features three different categories for youngsters of all abilities.

The Bupa Mini Great North Run is for girls and boys aged from 3 to 8 years and covers approximately 1 mile. The Bupa Junior Great North Run is divided into two age categories - for boys and girls aged 9 to 11 and for boys and girls aged 12 to 16 - both over a distance of approximately 3 miles.

All junior and mini runners will receive an event t-shirt, medal and finishers pack. All junior runners will be chip timed to give an accurate finishing time with times published on the Bupa Great Run website after the event. All three courses start and finish on the Newcastle side of the Quayside.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

This event is organised by Nova International whose registered office is at Newcastle House, Albany Court, Monarch Road, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE4 7YB. By entering the event you agree to abide by the Conditions of Entry and any race instructions given to you by the organisers and officials of the Great Run series.

Change of Address

If your address details change after you have submitted your application, you can login to your profile on www.greatrun.org and change your postal address. Approximately two weeks before the event Bupa Great Run will start the mailing process and your run pack will go to the address held at that point. Event Safety

No entries are permissible from people on roller skates, in wheelbarrows or carrying various objects for charity etc. Children being pushed in pushchairs are prohibited. No animals are permitted.

Participants in a Bupa Junior Great Run event should NOT be accompanied by an adult unless there is a special requirement that necessitates adult accompaniment.

Bupa Great Run is continuing in its mission to organise the world's best, safest and most enjoyable running events and hopes you will help in achieving this. Any participant who is found in breach of these terms and conditions will be excluded from future Bupa Great Run or other Great events. Please do not put someone else at risk.

Data Protection

The Bupa Great Run series complies with the Data Protection Act 1998 and you have the right of access to your personal records held on our computer.

Your name will be added to our mailing list so that Bupa Great Run can keep you informed about the Bupa Great Run series, sportswear and other Bupa Great Run series events and services. This information may also be made available to other carefully screened organisations to contact you. You are entitled to withdraw your consent to this process by ticking the appropriate box on your application form.

Race Numbers

For safety reasons and primarily for the identification by medical staff, Bupa Great Run strictly prohibits the swapping, sale, re-sale or transfer of race numbers in any Bupa Great Run event.

Event Cancellation

If the event is unable to take place due to unforeseen circumstances, we will endeavour to stage the event at a later date, but if this is not possible we will be entitled to cancel the event. In such circumstances, we will try to let you know in writing of the cancellation or delay. In the event of race cancellation we will refund your entry fee on request but will have no other liability to you for any costs or expenses you may incur as a result of that cancellation. In the event of a delay in the race which is due to unforeseen circumstances beyond our reasonable control, we will have no liability to you for any costs or expenses you may incur, although you may opt to cancel your place and in that case we will refund your entry fee.

Run Mementos

Only finishers will receive a commemorative medal and finisher's pack. Non participants are NOT eligible for event mementos.

Bupa Great Run reserves the right to change the style, size and type of event mementos offered to participants including medal and t-shirt.

Race Ejection

Bupa Great Run reserves the right to refuse an entrant's attendance at, and/or participation in any Bupa Great Run event and/or a Training Run.

Charity Entrants

By accepting a charity place into an event or by choosing to raise money for a charity during the entry process you consent to Bupa Great Run making your contact details available to the charity concerned.

Medical Conditions

It is strongly recommended that your child trains for the run and prepares for the challenge. You may wish to consult your doctor if you have any concerns about your child training for or participating in a Bupa Junior Great Run. Parents/guardians are reminded to complete the details on the back of your child's run number and that of the accompanying adult (if applicable).

Collection and use of information

You acknowledge and agree that the child's personal information (including medical information collected on the race number or collected by event medical staff during or after the event) can be stored, used and disclosed by Bupa Great Run in connection with the organisation, staging, promotion and administration of the event and for the compilation of statistical information. In the event of the child becoming ill during or after the event and receiving medical attention or treatment either from event medical staff, volunteer medical officers or any doctor or hospital, you authorise such persons to provide the child's details (including details of medical treatment) to the Medical Director of Bupa Great Run events or others authorised by him.

Age Limits

All participants must be aged between 9 and 16 (inclusive) on Saturday 18 September 2010.

Entry Fees

£15 for Bupa Junior Great North Run participants. If your entry is accepted your fee is not refundable. Consult your bank statement for confirmation of race entry.

Entry Limit

Applications will be accepted up to the entry limit in order of date received. Entries will be rejected after the closing date of Friday 10 September 2010 or earlier should the entry limit be reached by this date.

Wheelchairs
